DECEMBER 31 THROUGH JANUARY 2. ALSO JANUARY 16 FOR MLK DAY. HAPPY HOLIDAYS!






Teens and Tweens come on Fridays at 4:00 -5:00PM to enjoy playing chess with peers.

Gift YOURSELF!



 - You can use the Kindle to check out free eBooks from HCPL's collection or download books available on Amazon.com
 - You get to keep it for two weeks.
 - All you need is an HCPL library card.
