

Q: When is our Library MORE than a library?

Of course our Library has all the usual library offerings. But there is so much MORE!

ADULTS—Did you know our Library offers: **Citizenship** and **ESLClasses**—every Friday; **Computer Classes** through September 24 on Thursdays; **Green Thumb Gardening** class once a month in the evening; **Yoga with Sheila** Monday evenings every other week through November 23. (Starts September 14); **Page Turners Book Club**—monthly discussions open to all! **Planning for Retirement**—November 3 only, from 11-noon.

TEENS—Did you know the Library has programs on Tuesdays at 4PM just for YOU? Afterschool Gaming starts on September 8; Hack the Planet, a computer coding class especially for teens starts on September 15. It is not magic! (These two activities alternate weekly through the fall.); Practice SAT with Kaplan September 19.



FAMILIES AND KIDS—Do you know about **Pajama Story Time**—monthly for ALL ages! **Reading with a Furry Friend**—monthly chance for children to read to a certified therapy dog for young or reluctant readers; **Craft Corner** and **Creative Corner**—each occurs monthly through November; **Country Club**—a monthly celebration of different countries of the world with songs, art, games, etc., through November.


Toddler Story Time! is each

Gulf Coast Reads!



The goal of the Gulf Coast Reads program is to encourage readers throughout the Gulf Coast region to discuss a particular book with their neighbors, co-workers, friends and families during October. This year's selection is *The Promise* by Ann Weisgarber.

Set in Galveston in 1900, Ms. Weisgarber is a gifted storyteller who makes the time and the place come alive as she spins a tale of the tragic hurricane and an equally devastating storm of love, loss, and hidden secrets that changes lives.

So talk to your neighbors! Talk to your friends! ead together!

THEN, join us at OUR Library on Monday, October 5, 7-8PM, when Shelly Kelly will lead a discussion of that tragic time. Ms. Kelly is a former archivist with Rosenberg Library and is the co-author of *Through a Night of Horrors*—a collection of letters written by survivors immediately following the hurricane.
