

The beauty of hybrids is that they tend to be stronger and more versatile than either of their original sources. Now several programs are offered both in-person (limited numbers and masks required) and virtually. The programs for our younger patrons will remain solely virtual for a while—they don't really "get" social distancing—as will Bakers and Makers for Teens due to sharing ingredients, but the Library now has the capability of streaming meetings and programs



Covid creates a constantly changing scene! Continue to "check out" the Library's own calendar, Facebook page or Next Door for the most updated information.




Fridays weekly at 10AM in the Reading Garden behind the library All ages

Our Library is the 21st out of 26 Harris County libraries in size.

At the end of December (the latest data at this printing), it ranked:

4th in Overdrive check outs—22,084 **4th** in Reference questions—1,972

**5th** in Computer use—60,126 minutes

5th in Holds—3,871 processed

**6th** in In-person visits—5,675 patrons

7th in Circulation—25,012 items

checked out
